The East Muskingum Local School District will be registering students for kindergarten during the week of March 5-March 9, 2018. Children who will be five years old on or before **August 1, 2018**, are eligible to register for kindergarten.

Parents are to bring their child's birth certificate, immunization records and proof of residency. Proof of residency is a deed, building permit, rental agreement, property tax statement, voter registration card or completion of Form 5111 F2a or Form 5111 F2b (5111 forms must be notarized). These are the only forms which are accepted as Proof of Residency. If the child resides with someone other than a parent, custody papers should be brought to registration. Ohio law requires that all pupils admitted for initial entry to school present written evidence that they have received, or are in the process of receiving, immunization against poliomyelitis (OPV), diphtheria - pertussis - tetanus (DTAP), rubella and rubeola (MMR German Measles), and Varicella (chicken pox).

All children entering kindergarten shall be required to provide evidence of having received a three-dose series of Hepatitis B vaccine. Children will also be required to have 5 DTAP, 4 Polio (this includes at least one dose past fourth birthday), 2 MMR, and 2 Varicella, only if the child has not had the chickenpox disease.

Students should register at the school in their attendance area. Parents desiring Open Enrollment into East Muskingum need to register their child at the school of choice so we can include them in the screening process.
